One-on-One Support:

Receive assistance from an experienced instructional designer (ID) in determining how to make course modifications to align a course to the OEI Course Design rubric. Sign up for a time slot that works best for you, and received a combined total of 2 hours, dedicated with one of our experienced staff.

Instructional Design Consultation Initial Meeting:

You and the instructional designer (ID) will meet online for 1.25 hours to dive deep into your course. The ID will partner with you to offer clarity around any information provided in your review response document, as well as to design an actionable plan on how to modify your course to align with the OEI Course Design rubric.



Faculty Implements Actions Identified

You will determine how long you would like to have to incorporate actions identified in your initial meeting with you ID support person. You will use this time to implement the changes discussed, as well as queue up any items you would like to discuss further with you ID.



Instructional Design Consultation Follow up Meeting:

You will have the opportunity to meet with your online for in this final session, for 45 minutes. The ID will address any new question that arose during your implementation time, and/or review any areas of the rubric or course that you may still feel unclear about.



Faculty Implements Actions Identified

You will again have a period of time to implement the changes identified. Once you have implementing the action created by you and your ID, you will follow the process for re-submitting you course to OEI.

Please note: More information will be provided on how to resubmit your course during your second meeting with you ID.
